The most common causes of hand injuries:

- Carelessness
- Disregard for Safety Procedures
- Distractions

CONVIRON'S SAFETY RULES

1. Wear cut resistant gloves where risk of injury to your hands exist. The only exception is when you are working on equipment/machines with rotating parts.
2. Never remove machine safeguards. Do not put your fingers or your hands through, under, over, or around the guard.
3. When you're using a nail gun, stapler, utility knife etc, keep your other hand a safe distance away.
4. Be aware of pinch points.
5. Be aware of hot surfaces (while soldering, brazing, using the heat gun etc.)
