## FIRE SAFETY

Preventing fires is everyone's job. We all need to be alert to anything that could cause a fire & take responsibility to report any problem areas so they can be corrected. Here are some reminders about fire prevention:

### NEVER BLOCK fire extinguishers or electrical panels!

**3 Feet clearance** must be kept in front of all electrical panels, fire extinguishers, fire alarms and breaker boxes.



#### Practice good workplace Housekeeping

Clutter contributes to fires by providing fuel & by preventing access to exits and emergency equipment.



Store flammable chemicals in fire proof cabinet after use.



DO NOT do any torching, welding or other hot work around flammable chemicals, rags, paper products or cardboard boxes.

Place oily rags or paper towels in a covered metal container.



Inspect your power tools and extension cords for:

- Cracks
- Damage insulation
- Frayed line cord
- Loose parts
- any other damage



Never attempt Electrical repairs!

Hand the damage tool or extension cord to your Supervisor immediately.



Learn how to use the Fire Extinguisher

Remember the Phrase **PASS**

**1 Pull**  
the pin



**2 Aim**  
at the base  
of the fire



**3 Squeeze**  
the handle



**4 Sweep**  
from side  
to side
